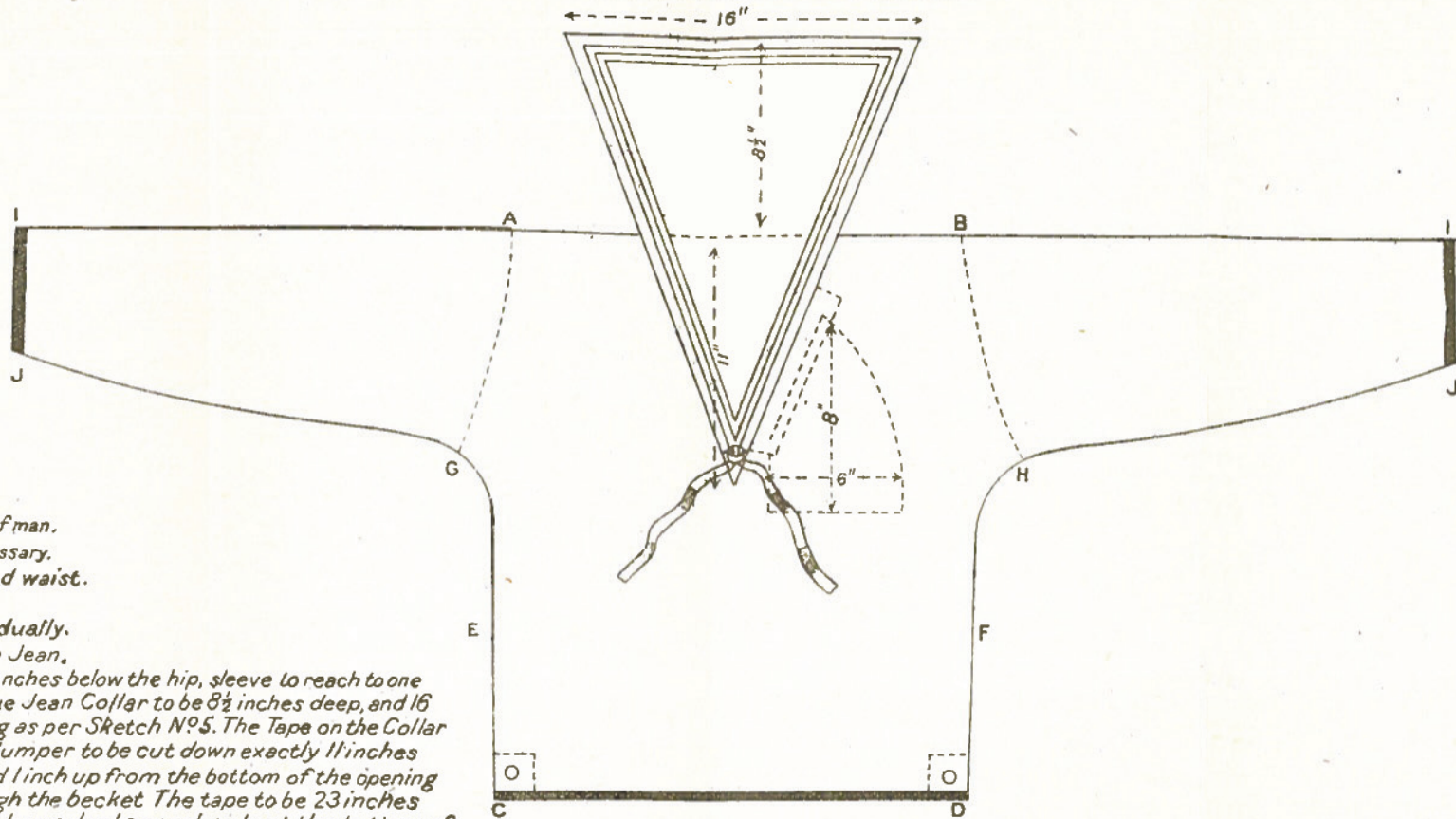


WHITE UNIFORM JUMPER



- A.B. According to breadth of man.
- A.G.B.H. 10" or larger if necessary.
- C.D.E.F. Fairly tight round waist.
- I.J. Fairly tight fitting.
- G.E.H.F. To be reached gradually.
- I.J.C.D. Bound with 1/2 inch Jean.

Length of Jumper to be 3 inches below the hip, sleeve to reach to one inch above wristbone. Blue Jean Collar to be 8 1/2 inches deep, and 16 inches across, with braiding as per Sketch N^o 5. The Tape on the Collar to be sewn on by hand. Jumper to be cut down exactly 11 inches and a becket to be worked 1 inch up from the bottom of the opening and the tape rove through the becket. The tape to be 23 inches long. Two eyelet holes to be worked on each side at the bottom of the Jumper, one on each side of the seam. Pocket to be inside on left breast, size of pocket to be 8 inches by 6 inches; opening to be 6 inches wide.

The White Working Jumper is to be exactly the same as the White Uniform Jumper except that it is fitted with a plain single Duck Collar, instead of Blue Jean Collar, and is not bound round the bottom and ends of sleeves with Blue Jean, and has no patches round eyelet holes.
